2. **VAT:** VAT payable on the hammer price.
3. **Commission:** 10% plus VAT, on the hammer price (5% on the balance over £1,000 per lot)
4. **Payment Terms:** Debit card (no credit/business debit cards). Cash (up to £10,000). Cheques (with suitable identification).
5. **Registration:** Anyone wishing to purchase must register for a buyer's number, available on viewing and sale days.
6. **Removal:** Each lot, at the fall of the hammer, shall be at the sole risk and expense of the buyer and shall be paid for and removed within 7 days (viz. by Saturday 22nd June). Items are left at the purchasers own risk. **Forklift facilities will be available until 5pm on sale day to assist purchasers to load – by arrangement thereafter for 6 days only.**
